1.0 Campus Amenities

The following initiatives have been proposed for implementation:

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| 1.1 The current vending machines on campus provide limited choices and do not support all payment methods, particularly Touch 'n Go (TNG). To address this, a proposal has been made to introduce vending machines with TNG payment support. | PSDC<br>Management |
| 1.2 There is currently no water cooler available in or around the new Spark area. The installation of water coolers has been proposed to ensure easy access to drinking water for students.  | PSDC<br>Management |
| 1.3 The campus currently lacks a sufficient number of rubbish bins, leading to inconvenience for students and staff. Management has agreed to add more rubbish bins throughout the campus to improve cleanliness and accessibility.          | PSDC<br>Management |

## 2.0 Campus Environment & Infrastructure

The committee reviewed several issues related to the campus environment and infrastructure. The following areas were identified for improvement and development:

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| 2.1 Students and staff have highlighted challenges in finding available parking. To address this, the existing parking sensor system (which tracks and displays the number of available spaces) will be reactivated to improve convenience and efficiency.   | PSDC<br>Management                               |
| 2.2 Traffic congestion is a recurring issue during peak hours, especially between 4:30 p.m. and 6:30 p.m. To mitigate this, security guards will be assigned during these hours to manage vehicle movement and prevent cars from blocking the yellow box areas, which often causes traffic jams.                                       | The security guard<br>of PSDC                    |
| 2.3 Wi-Fi access remains inconsistent in several parts of the campus, particularly in Block 3 and the library. Management has committed to expanding coverage within the next one year to ensure a more stable and reliable internet connection for students and staff.  | PSDC<br>Management                               |
| 2.4 The Ombak area on the first floor has been reported to have inadequate lighting, creating safety and visibility concerns. A proposal for brighter lighting installation is currently under review to enhance the environment.  | PSDC<br>Management                               |
| 2.5 Due to the hot climate and rising concerns over student comfort, cooling solutions such as water cooler fans have been proposed for installation in upstairs areas. This initiative is currently under evaluation for feasibility and implementation.  | PSDC<br>Management                               |
| 2.6 The campus fish pond has been identified as an area with potential for improvement. Plans include installing an aquatic circulation system, introducing decorative elements, and adding fish to enhance the aesthetic and environmental quality of the space.  | PSDC<br>Management                               |
| 2.7 The Sparc area is currently undergoing renovation to improve its facilities and overall environment. Discussions regarding the needs of students will be carried out after the renovation is completed. ### 3.0 Canteen & Food Options

3.1 Vegetarian food section in the canteen has been proposed to provide more inclusive meal options for students and staff. Management will communicate with the current food merchants to introduce this section and ensure a wider variety of choices.

### 4.0 Clubs and Planning events

4.1 The Karate Club and Ping Pong Club have requested first aid items to support their activities. The item list has already been submitted to management, who will follow up within two weeks. Facility members are required to ensure that the necessary items are available and maintained for student safety.

4.2 The Karate Club has requested floor mats (8× 8), total 64 pieces, to ensure a safe and suitable training environment for members. For the Ping Pong Club, Dr. Tan will follow up on the required equipment with the Head of Facilities, based on the number of students registered for the activity. Management will review the request and provide updates on the procurement process.

4.3 The introduction of Pickleball is currently under consideration. The PSDC CEO has conducted a preliminary survey within the committee and among teachers to gather feedback regarding the estimated costs of rackets, nets, and the overall popularity of the sport among students and staff. This information will serve as the basis for evaluating the feasibility of introducing Pickleball as a new campus activity. Further updates will be provided once the survey results and cost analysis are reviewed in detail. In addition, the CEO suggested utilizing the existing basketball court as the venue for Pickleball activities. However, the suitability of the court height and related requirements will need to be further assessed before implementation.

#### 4.4 AED Equipment and Training Talks

To enhance campus safety and ensure preparedness for medical emergencies, Automated External Defibrillator (AED) units will be introduced. These sessions will explain the functions of the AED, demonstrate its proper usage, and raise awareness about the importance of timely response during cardiac emergencies.
